War Memorials Trust is holding a series of workshops in Northern Ireland from 19<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> September 2016 in Derry/Londonderry, Enniskillen and Belfast. These are designed to provide advice and information on war memorial conservation as well as offering an opportunity for networking. Issues on the agenda include best conservation practice, available grant funding and the work of the charity.

The same workshop will be run three times; in Derry/Londonderry, Enniskillen and Belfast to give as many people as possible the chance to attend.
